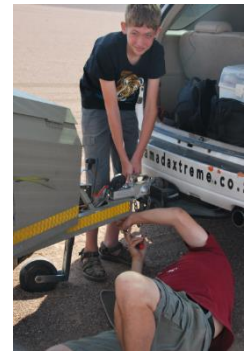


**Day 11 - 21 December 2015 (335 - 10 hours) Puros Camp Site – Palm wag**

We left Puro early morning heading again for Palm wag for the second time, we had to use Palm wag for a stopover before we enter the Skeleton Coast Park.
